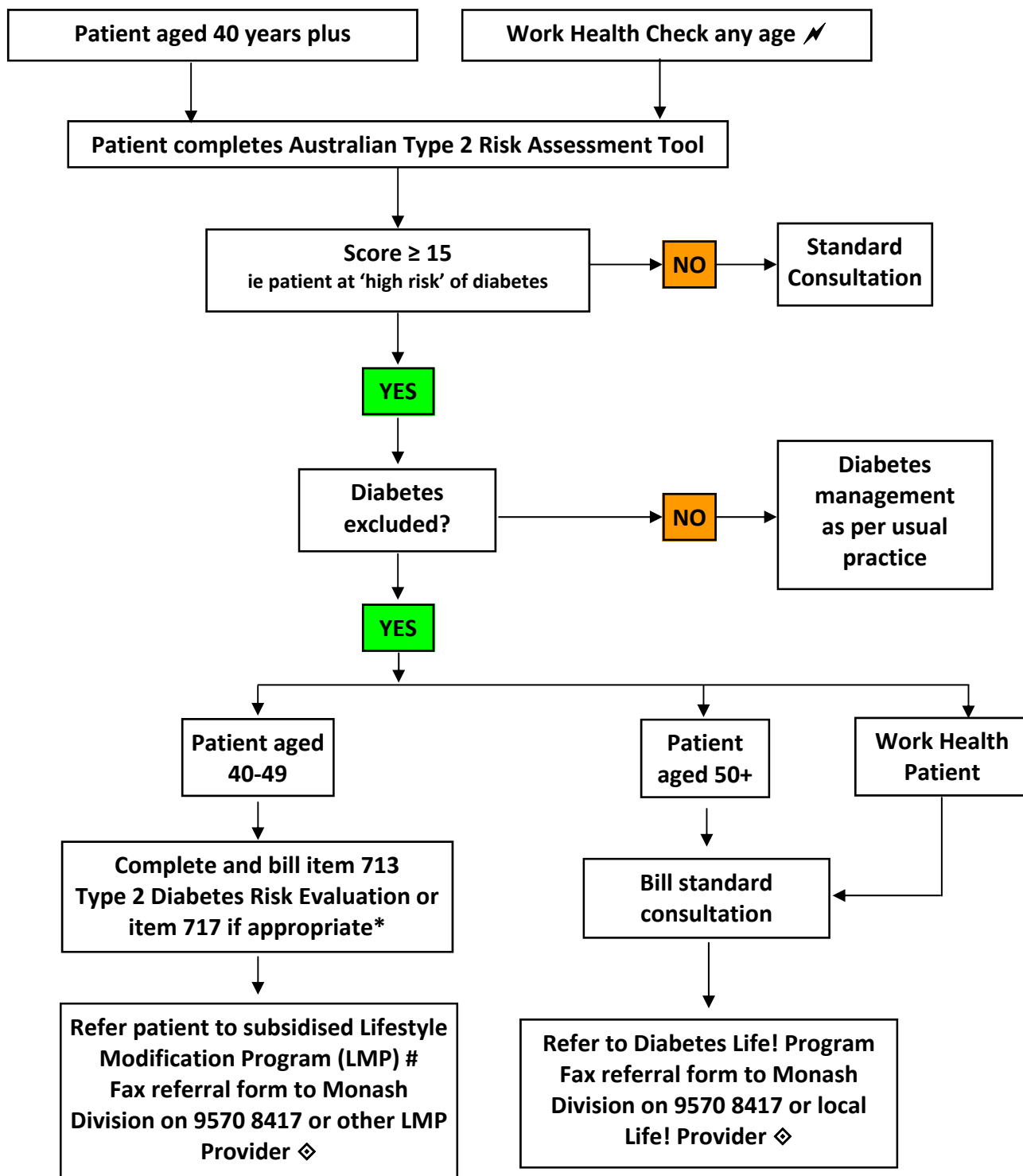


Referral Pathways for Diabetes Prevention Groups



⚡ *Work Health Check carried out at employee's place of work. Employee will have been advised to see GP for preventative health strategies,*

* *Medicare eligibility for Item 713—rebate payable only once every 3 years for patients aged 40-49 years, or when more than 3 years has elapsed since item 717 claimed.*

Patients may be referred to a subsidised LMP if they score ≥ 15 on the diabetes risk assessment tool and have had :
 713—Type 2 Diabetes Risk Evaluation (40-49 years) or
 717—45-49 year old health check, or
 710— Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Adult Health Check (15-54 years)
